## **Ambassador Pinzón Congratulates President Trump and Vice President Pence**

Following the inauguration of President Donald Trump and Vice President Mike Pence, Colombian Ambassador to the United States Juan Carlos Pinzón issued the following congratulatory statement:

## **Former SOUTHCOM Commander General John Kelly to Lead DHS**

On January 20, General John Kelly was confirmed as U.S. Secretary of Homeland Security. Ambassador Pinzón took the opportunity to extend Colombia’s wishes to General Kelly, who previously served as Commander of the U.S. Southern Command:

*“On behalf of the Embassy of Colombia, we congratulate Secretary John Kelly as he steps in to lead the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.*

*“The close U.S.-Colombia partnership has become one of the most important strategic alliances in our region thanks to the service and commitment from leaders such as Secretary Kelly. In his previous capacity as Commander of the U.S. Southern Command, Secretary Kelly was instrumental in strengthening the bond between our two countries and advancing peace and prosperity*

*throughout Latin America.*

*“We look forward to working with Secretary Kelly and the Trump Administration to ensure the U.S.-Colombia partnership remains strong and prosperous in the years ahead.”*

During his confirmation hearing before the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee, General Kelly highlighted Colombia’s incredible progress through efforts with the United States such as Plan Colombia and said that Colombians are “exporters of security” in Latin America.


